Designed by the Berroco Design Team / Skill level: Intermediate



## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Back Width: (20, 22, 24) [27, 30, 33] / (51, 56, 61) [68.5, 76, 84] cm  
(Fronts do not meet)

Length: (27, 29½, 32) [28½, 30, 32½]" / (68.5, 75, 81.5) [72.5, 76, 82.5] cm

**Note:** Since this shrug is not designed to meet in the front, the bust measurements are very forgiving and each size given will fit a wide range of sizes.

## YARN

**BERROCO SPREE** (50 grs): (6, 7, 9) [9, 10, 12] balls #9407 Chili (MC), and (3, 4, 5) [5, 5, 6] balls #94127 Plum (CC)

## NEEDLES and NOTIONS

16" / 40 cm and 32" / 80 cm circular needles, size 5 / 3.75 mm or size to obtain gauge

1 set double-pointed needles, or preferred needles for working small circumferences, size 5 / 3.75 mm  
4 stitch markers (1 a different color for BOR)

6 removable stitch markers  
Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

22 sts and 30 rows = 4" / 10 cm in St st

*Gauge is measured after blocking. To save time and ensure accurate measurements, take time to check gauge.*

**Berroco Spree™**

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We recommend using yarns called for in our instructions. Every effort has been made to ensure that directions contained in this book are accurate and complete, however errors do occur. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters, human or typographical errors.

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## CONSTRUCTION NOTES

Yoke/Sleeves of this garment are worked sideways from right sleeve cuff to left sleeve cuff. Squares are worked in the round from the outside to the center, and joined as you go to form lower body and fronts/collar.

### YOKE/SLEEVE

With dpns, or preferred needles for working small circumferences, cast on 50 sts. Pm and join for working in the round. Work even in St st until piece measures 2" / 5 cm from cast-on.

**Inc Rnd:** K2, M1R, knit to last 2 sts, M1L, k2—2 sts inc'd. Rep Inc Rnd every (13th, 9th, 7th) [6th, 6th, 4th] round (7, 10, 13) [15, 15, 18] times more—(66, 72, 78) [82, 82, 88] sts.

Work even until sleeve measures 16" / 40.5 cm from cast on. Mark first and last stitches of last round—A and (F, F, F) [H, H, H] on schematic.

**Note:** Next section is worked flat in rows, so if you are using dpns, switch to preferred needles for working flat.

**Next Row (RS):** Knit.

Work in St st in rows until flat section measures (10, 11, 12) [9, 10, 11]" / (25.5, 28, 30.5) [23, 25.5, 28] cm from last set of markers, end on WS. Mark first and last stitch of last row—B and (E, E, E) [G, G, G] on schematic.



Work even until piece measures (X, X, X) [9, 10, 11]" / (X, X, X) [23, 25.5, 28] cm from last set of markers, end on WS. Mark first and last stitch of last row—C and (D, D, D) [F, F, F] on schematic.

**For Sizes (X, X, X) [27, 30, 33] / (X, X, X) [68.5, 76, 84] cm ONLY:** Work even until piece measures (X, X, X) [9, 10, 11]" / (X, X, X) [23, 25.5, 28] cm from last set of markers, end on WS. Mark first and last stitch of last row—D and E on schematic.

**For ALL Sizes:** Slip stitches back onto dpns, or preferred needles for working small circumferences. Pm and join for working in the round. Work even in St st until sleeve measures the same as other sleeve from the last set of markers to the last inc worked.

**Dec Rnd:** K2, k2tog, knit to last 4 sts, SSK, k2—2 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Rnd every (13th, 9th, 7th) [6th, 6th, 4th] round (7, 10, 13) [15, 15, 18] times more—50 sts.

Work even in St st for 2" / 5 cm. Bind off all stitches.

## LOWER SQUARES

### SQUARE 1

With RS facing, using longer circular needle, pick up and knit (56, 60, 66) [50, 56, 60] sts between A and B markers on yoke, pm, [cast on (56, 60, 66) [50, 56, 60] sts, pm] twice, cast on (56, 60, 66) [50, 56, 60] sts—(224, 240, 264) [200, 224, 240] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Slip markers as you come to them.

**Note:** As you decrease, when there are too few stitches to fit comfortably on circular needle, change to dpns or preferred needles for working small circumferences.

**Rnd 1:** Purl.

**Rnd 2:** \* K2tog, knit to 2 sts before marker, SSK, sm; rep from \* around—8 sts dec'd,

**Rnd 3:** Purl.

**Rnd 4:** Rep Rnd 2 —8 sts dec'd.

**Rnd 5:** Knit.

Rep Rnds 4 and 5 (8, 9, 10) [8, 9, 11] times more, then rep Rnd 4 ONLY (17, 18, 20) [14, 16, 16] times—8 sts. Break yarn, leaving an 8" / 20.5 cm end. Thread end into tapestry needle and draw through all sts on needles. Pull up tightly and secure.

### SQUARE 2

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit (56, 60, 66) [50, 56, 60] sts along LH edge of Square 1, pm; pick up and knit (56, 60, 66) sts between B and C markers on yoke, pm, cast on (56, 60, 66) [50, 56, 60] sts, pm, cast on (56, 60, 66) (50, 56, 60) sts—(224, 240, 264) [200, 223, 240] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Complete as for Square 1.

**For Sizes (20, 22, 24) [X, X, X] / (51, 56, 61) [X, X, X] cm ONLY:**

### SQUARE 3

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts along LH edge of Square 2, pm, [cast on (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts, pm] twice, cast on (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts—(224, 240, 264) [X, X, X] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Complete as for Square 1.

### SQUARE 4

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts along LH edge of Square 3, pm, [cast on (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts, pm] twice, cast on (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts—(224, 240, 264) [X, X, X] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Complete as for Square 1.

### SQUARE 5

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit (56,



60, 66) [X, X, X] sts along LH edge of Square 4, pm, pick up and knit (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts between D and E markers on yoke, pm, cast on (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts, pm, cast on (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts—(224, 240, 264) [X, X, X] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Complete as for Square 1.

### SQUARE 6

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts along LH edge of Square 5, pm, pick up and knit (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts between E and F markers on yoke, pm, cast on (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts, pm, cast on (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts—(224, 240, 264) [X, X, X] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Complete as for Square 1.

### SQUARE 7

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts along LH edge of Square 6, pm, [cast on (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts, pm] twice, cast on (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts—(224, 240, 264) [X, X, X] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Complete as for Square 1.

### SQUARE 8

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts along LH edge of Square 7, pm, pick up

and knit (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts along RH edge of Square 1, cast on (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts, pm, cast on (56, 60, 66) [X, X, X] sts—(224, 240, 264) [X, X, X] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Complete as for Square 1.

**For Sizes (X, X, X) [27, 30, 33] / (X, X, X) [68.5, 76, 84] cm ONLY:**

### SQUARE 3

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts along LH edge of Square 2, pm, pick up and knit (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts between C and D markers on yoke, pm, cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts, pm, cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts—(X, X, X) [200, 224, 240] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Complete as for Square 1.

### SQUARE 4

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts along LH edge of Square 3, pm, [cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts, pm] twice, cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts—(X, X, X) [200, 224, 240] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Complete as for Square 1.

### SQUARE 5

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts along LH edge of Square 4, [cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts, pm] twice, cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts—(X, X, X) [200, 224, 240] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Complete as for Square 1.

### SQUARE 6

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts along LH edge of Square 5, pick up and knit (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts between E and F markers on yoke, cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts, pm, cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts—(X, X, X) [200, 224, 240] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Complete as for Square 1.

### SQUARE 7

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts along LH edge of Square 6, pick up and knit (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts between F and G markers on yoke, cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts, pm, cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts—(X, X, X) [200, 224, 240] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Complete as for Square 1.

### SQUARE 8

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts along LH edge of Square 7, pick up



and knit (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts between G and H markers on yoke, cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts, pm, cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts—(X, X, X) [200, 224, 240] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Complete as for Square 1.

### SQUARE 9

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts along LH edge of Square 8, [cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts, pm] twice, cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts—(X, X, X) [200, 224, 240] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Complete as for Square 1.

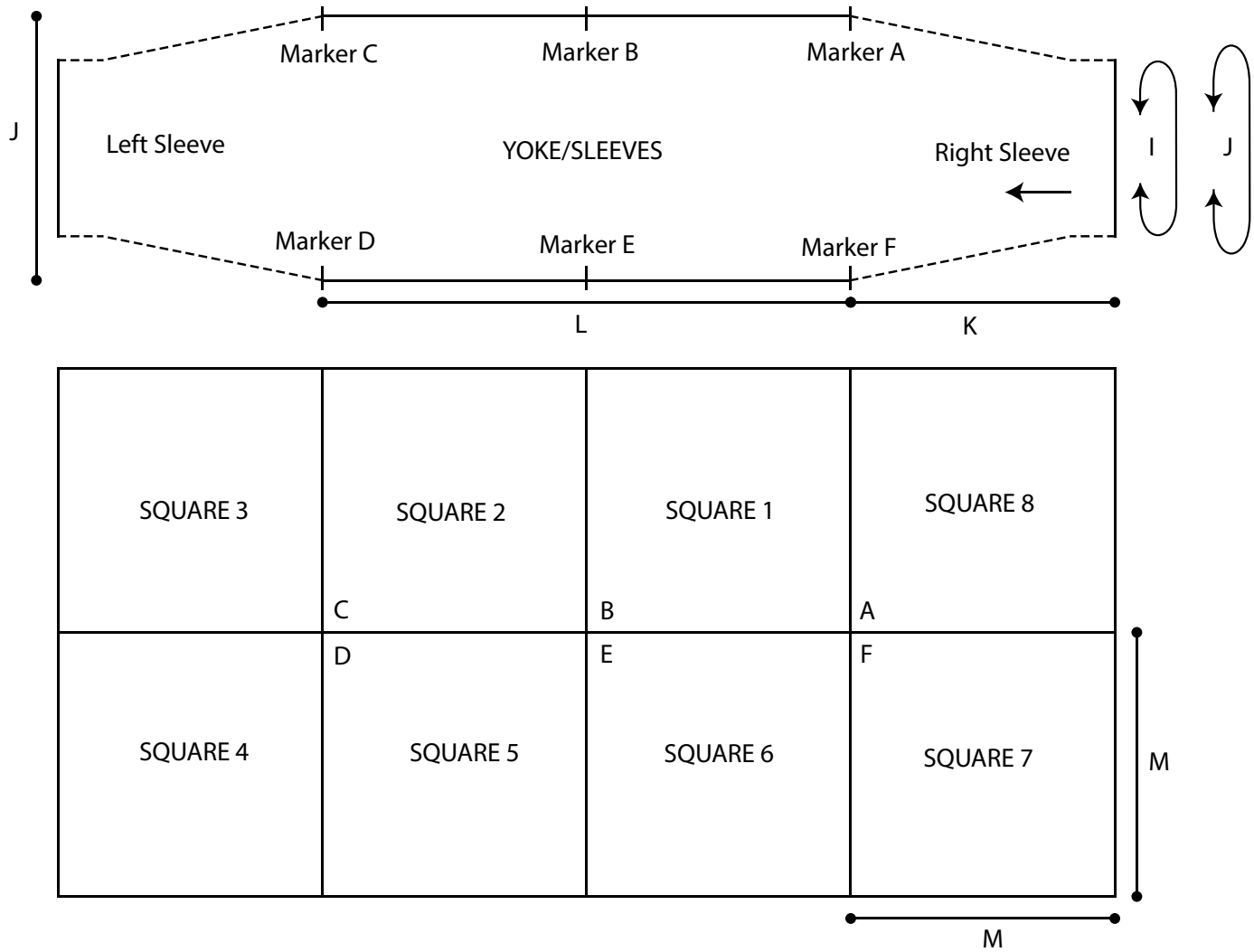
### SQUARE 10

With RS facing, using circular needle, pick up and knit (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts along LH edge of Square 9, pm, pick up and knit (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts along RH edge of Square 1, pm, cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts, pm, cast on (X, X, X) [50, 56, 60] sts—(X, X, X) [200, 224, 240] sts. Place BOR marker and join for working in the round. Complete as for Square 1.

### For ALL SIZES: FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

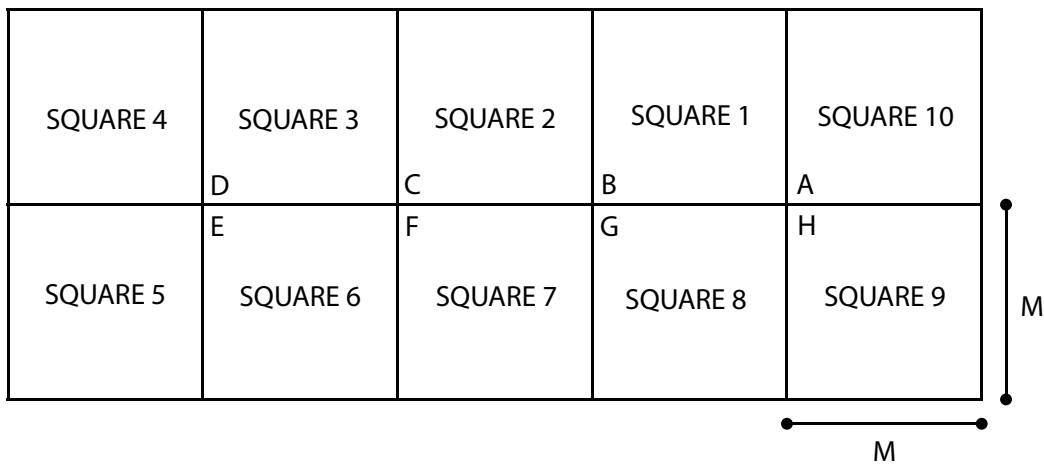
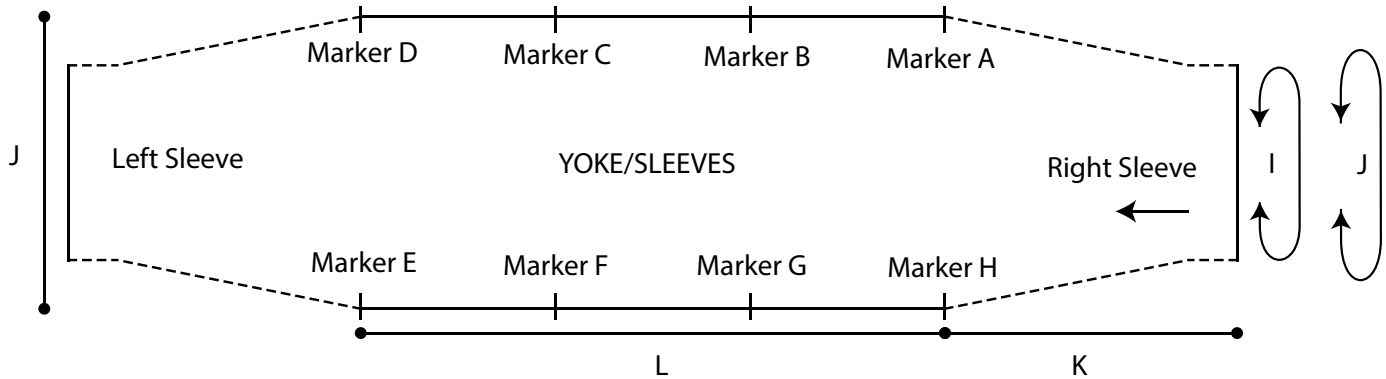
J (Upper Sleeve Circumference / Yoke Length): (12, 13, 14) [15, 15, 16]" / (30.5, 33, 35.5) [38, 38, 40.5] cm

K (Sleeve Length): 16" / 40.5 cm

L (Yoke Width): (30, 33, 36) [36, 40, 44]" / (76, 84, 91.5) [91.5, 101.5, 112] cm

M (Sides of Squares): (10, 11, 12) [9, 10, 11]" / 25.5, 28, 30.5) [23, 25.5, 28] cm

J (Upper Sleeve Circumference / Yoke Length): (12, 13, 14) [15, 15, 16]" / (30.5, 33, 35.5) [38, 38, 40.5] cm

K (Sleeve Length): 16" / 40.5 cm

L (Yoke Width): (30, 33, 36) [36, 40, 44]" / (76, 84, 91.5) [91.5, 101.5, 112] cm

M (Sides of Squares): (10, 11, 12) [9, 10, 11]" / 25.5, 28, 30.5) [23, 25.5, 28] cm



## STANDARD ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

**beg:** beginning  
**BOR:** beginning of round  
**CC:** contrasting color  
**CDD:** Centered Double Decrease—Slip 2 together (as if to k2tog), knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over  
**cn:** cable needle  
**dec:** decrease  
**dpn(s):** double pointed needle(s)  
**end on WS:** end having just completed a Wrong Side row.  
**end on RS:** end having just completed a Right Side row  
**Garter St:** Knit EVERY row when working back and forth in rows. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working in the round.  
**inc:** increase  
**k:** knit  
**k tbl:** knit through the back loop(s)  
**k2tog:** knit 2 stitches together  
**k3tog:** knit 3 stitches together  
**kfb:** knit in the front and back of the next st  
**LH:** left hand  
**LLI:** Left Lifted Increase—Insert LH needle into the purl bump one row below the st just worked on the RH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)  
**M1:** Make 1—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).  
**M1L:** Make 1 Left—Work as for M1.  
**M1p:** Make 1 purl—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).  
**M1pL:** Make 1 purl Left—Work as for M1p.  
**M1pR:** Make 1 purl Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).  
**M1R:** Make 1 Right—Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).  
**MC:** main color  
**p:** purl  
**p tbl:** purl through the back loop(s)  
**p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together  
**p3tog:** purl 3 stitches together  
**pat(s):** pattern(s)  
**pm:** place marker

**psso:** pass slipped stitch over knit stitch  
**rep:** repeat  
**Rev St st:** Reverse Stockinette Stitch—Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round.  
**RH:** right hand  
**RLI:** Right Lifted Increase—Insert RH needle into the purl bump of the next st on the LH needle and knit into this st (1 st inc'd)  
**rnd(s):** round(s)  
**RS:** right side  
**sl:** slip  
**sm:** slip marker  
**SSK:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.  
**SSP:** Slip 2 stitches knitwise, transfer these 2 stitches back to left hand needle, purl 2 together through the back loops.  
**SSSK:** Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3 together.  
**st(s):** stitch(es)  
**St st:** Stockinette Stitch—Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working back and forth in rows. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round.  
**tbl:** through back loop(s)  
**w&t:** wrap and turn, a method of concealing a hole created in short row shaping. On RS rows: With yarn held in front, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the back. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. On WS Rows: With yarn held in back, slip next stitch purlwise, then bring yarn between needles to the front. Slip that same stitch back to the left needle. Turn your work. Unless otherwise indicated, each time you come to a wrapped stitch when working subsequent rows, slip the wrap back over stitch and onto needle, then work the wrap together with its accompanying stitch.  
**WS:** wrong side  
**wyib:** with yarn in back  
**wyif:** with yarn in front  
**yo:** yarn over
