BACK

With smaller straight needles, cast on 82(90-102-110-122-130) sts.

Ribbing: Row 1 (RS): K2, * p2, k2, rep from * across.

Row 2: P2, * k2, p2, rep from * across. Rep these 2 rows until piece measures 4" from beg, end on WS. Change to larger needles and work even in St st until piece measures 11" from beg, end on WS.

Shape Raglan Armholes: Bind off 3(3-4-5-6-7) sts at beg of the next 2 rows – 76(84-94-100-110-116) sts.

For sizes Medium, Large, 1X and 2X ONLY:

Dec Row 1 (RS): K2, k3tog, k to last 5 sts, sl 1, k2tog, psso, k2 - 90(96-106-112) sts. Rep this dec every RS row 0(1-4-6) times more, end on WS – 90(92-90-88) sts.

For ALL sizes: Dec Row 2 (RS): K2, k2, tog, k to last 4 sts, SSK, k2 – 74(82-88-90-88-86) sts. Rep this dec every RS row 10(18-24-25-24-23) times more, then every other RS row 7(3-0-0-0) times, end on WS. Bind off remaining 40 sts.

FRONT

Work same as back.

SIFFVFS

With smaller straight needles, cast on 62(62-66-70-74-78) sts. Work in ribbing same as back for 4 rows, end on WS. Change to larger needles and St st.

Shape Raglan Cap: Bind off 3(3-4-5-6-7) sts at beg of the next 2 rows – 56(56-58-60-62-64) sts.

Dec Row (RS): K2, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, SSK, k2 – 54(54-56-58-60-62) sts. Rep this dec every RS row




10(10-11-11-12) times more, then every other RS row 7(7-7-8-9-9) times, end on WS. Bind off remaining 20 sts.

FINISHING

Sew raglan caps to raglan armholes.

Neckband: With RS facing, using circular needle, beg at center back neck, pick up and k20 sts to seam, 20 sts along top of sleeve, 40 sts across front neck, 20 sts along top of second sleeve, then 20 sts across remaining back neck – 120 sts. Mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up. Work even in k2, p2 ribbing for 4 rnds. Bind off in ribbing. Sew side and sleeve seams.

M1pL: Work as for M1p.

M1pR: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

p tbl: purl through the back loop(s)

pat(s): pattern(s)
pm: place marker

psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch **p2tog:** purl 2 stitches together

p2sso: pass 2 slip stitches over knit stitch

p3tog: purl 3 stitches together

rem: remaining rep: repeat RH: right hand rnd(s): round(s) RS: right side

sl: slip

sm: slip marker

SSK: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

sl st: slip stitch
